

Delegations (responsibilities)

- Set at the start of each term, up to maximum of 5 Key projects.
- Ensure the Key projects fit within the intersect(overlap) of the Te Arawa 2050 vision and the community outcomes of the Rotorua Lakes Council.
- Ensure meaningful and thorough engagement with Te Arawa whānui (families) and others, as determined and in accordance with Councils legislative responsibilities on the key projects.
- Maintain support and guidance, as required, to ensure the effective implementation and risk management of the key projects that support the Te Arawa 2050 Vision.
- Receive and report Key project progress and ensure accountability for achieving the key projects, including risks and mitigations.
- Uphold the ‘Ngā Mātāpono me ngā uaratanga (Principles and Values)’ of the 2015 Manatū Whakaaetanga Partnership Agreement.
- Provide financial, political and operational feedback on the agreed Key Projects to Council.
