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## 1. RMA DELEGATION RULES AND GENERAL DELEGATIONS

### Delegation Rules

1. The exercise of delegated powers and the performance of delegated functions and duties by Delegates delegated powers, duties and functions under this Delegations Register must be undertaken in a manner which:
  - (a) Gives effect to the purposes and principles of the Resource Management Act 1991 ('RMA');
  - (b) Complies with any restrictions, exceptions and conditions prescribed in the RMA (including the duties and restrictions prescribed in Part 3 of the RMA);
  - (c) Conforms with Council's decision-making responsibilities, as prescribed by the Local Government Act 2002 (as amended);
  - (d) Complies with all applicable Council-adopted plans, policies and procedures; and
  - (e) Complies with any restrictions, rules, exceptions and conditions set out in this Delegations Register.
2. Delegates who are Council employees must at all times exercise the power, or perform the duty or responsibility delegated to them, in accordance with:
  - (a) their position description; and
  - (b) under the direction and supervision of the Council officer/s to whom they report.
3. It is the responsibility of each officer to whom a Delegate reports, to ensure that that Delegate has the appropriate and necessary skills, judgment and qualifications to exercise the power or undertake the duty or responsibility delegated to him/her.
4. Where more than one officer is given delegated authority, any one of the officers may individually exercise the power or perform the duty delegated (unless expressly provided otherwise), so long as the decision or action is within the ambit of that officer's position description and in conformity with a direction given by that officer's direct supervisor and/or group manager.
5. Council Officer Delegates may, with the approval of the Chief Executive, refer any RMA matter to the RMA Policy Committee for:
  - Consideration and a determination (if the matter falls within the Committee's decision-making function); or
  - Consideration and referral to Council for a decision (if the matter falls within the Committee's recommendatory-only function).

### General RMA Delegations

#### Chief Executive Delegations confirmed

1. Council confirms its broad delegation of Council powers, duties and functions to the Chief Executive on 4 November 2010 ("the Chief Executive Delegations"), in which the Chief Executive was conferred, pursuant to sections 34A and 223 of the Resource Management Act 1991, "the responsibilities and duties permitted to be delegated under that legislation".

#### Delegations to Council Officers

2. In addition to the Chief Executive Delegations and in accordance with the powers conferred on it by section 34A of the RMA, Council delegates such of Council's powers, duties and functions as are specified in this Delegations Register to Council Officers.

#### Delegation to engage Independent Hearings Commissioners/Panels

3. Council delegates to the Chair of the RMA Policy Committee and Council's GMgr.OG (jointly) the power to select and engage, on a case by case basis, one or more hearings commissioners from

Council's pre-appointed Panel of Independent Hearings Commissioners ('Commissioners')<sup>1</sup> to hear and determine delegated RMA matters, on condition that:

- (a) each Commissioner engagement conforms with the purpose for which that Commissioner has been appointed by Council; and
  - (b) the relevant Commissioner satisfies Council's mandatory accreditation and training requirements.
4. For information and monitoring purposes, the GMgr.OG must report all decisions made by Commissioners under delegated authority to the next appropriate RMA Policy Committee meeting.

#### **Delegations to Independent Hearings Commissioners**

5. In accordance with the powers conferred by section 34A of the RMA and as required under s.100A, Council hereby delegates to each Council-appointed Commissioner, such of Council's powers, duties and functions to hear and determine (or recommend in the case of notices of requirement for requiring authorities other than Council) resource consent applications, notices of requirement and objections under the RMA as are more particularly specified in this Delegations Register.
6. Commissioners may only exercise the powers and perform the duties delegated to them, once engaged to hear and/or determine or recommend a particular matter.

#### **Officers in acting capacities**

7. Delegations made to Council officers apply also to those officers who, from time to time, have been authorised or appointed to undertake an acting role in respect of that particular office (e.g. whilst the officer holder is on leave). For the duration of the officer's absence, the "acting" officer is authorised to exercise the powers and perform the duties conferred on, or delegated to, the absent officer by this Delegation and to sign all documents which that officer is authorised or required to sign under the RMA.

#### **Effect of delegation**

8. As provided by section 34A(4) of the RMA:
- (a) All Delegates may, without confirmation by Council, exercise or perform a function, power, or duty delegated to them in like manner and with the same effect as Council could itself have exercised or performed it;
  - (b) No delegation affects the performance or exercise of any function, power, or duty by Council.

#### **Ancillary powers, duties and functions**

9. For the avoidance of doubt, all delegated powers, duties and functions include the delegation of any ancillary powers, duties and functions necessary to give effect to those delegated powers, duties or functions.

#### **Exclusions**

10. As provided by section 34A(1) of the RMA, no Delegate has the power to:
- (a) Approve a proposed district plan under clause 17 of Schedule 1; or
  - (b) Sub-delegate any of the powers, duties and functions delegated to them in this Delegations Register, either to Council Officers or others.

#### **Continuity of Delegations**

11. All Council delegations to the Chief Executive, to Council Officers and to Commissioners remain in force until varied or revoked by Council.

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<sup>1</sup> Being persons who have been appointed as members of a panel of independent hearings commissioners for the purpose of being selected on a case-by-case basis, either individually or as a panel, to hear and determine resource consent applications, notices of requirement and objections under the RMA.
