### Parks where you CAN exercise your dog:

You are allowed to exercise your dog in certain council reserve areas. The person exercising the dog must be able to control it as if it were on a lead. If you cannot stop or retrieve your dog with a call or a whistle, then you cannot exercise it off a lead. The parks and reserves where you can exercise your dog off a lead are listed below. Also shown are the parks and reserves where NO dogs are allowed at any time (see maps inside).

- Ngongotaha Reeme Street Reserve, from Reeme Street to the wooden barrier at the Taui Street end of the reserve
- Ngongotaha Western Road Reserve (Elliott Park). Access from Western Road
- Boielle Park Flat area, entrance off Kawaha Point Road (Central to Koutu/Kawaha Point)
- Fairview Road Reserve Access from Bell, Fairview & Park Roads
- Linton Park East & West Access from Edmund Road, Kamahi Place and Homedale Street
- Blomfield Street Reserve Western perimeter Goldie Street/Pukehangi Road
- Pullar Park Between Sunset Primary and Sunset Junior High Schools, adjacent to Otamatea Stream
- Wright Park Access off Icarus Place, Pegasus Drive, Castor Place, Helena Place & Orion Street
- Simmonds Crescent Reserve (now Tihi Reserve) Access off Simmonds Crescent, Day Place & Tihi Road
- Boyes Park- Access off Carlton, Wylie, Duncan & Ranolf Streets
- Pererika Street (Town Belt) Area from Model Railway clubrooms to Trade Central entrance
- McIntyreAvenue Access off McIntyre Avenue & Marguerita Street
- Larcy Road Reserve Access from Larcy & Lynbert Roads
- Coulter Road Reserve Access from Wingrove & Coulter Roads
- Corlett Street Access from Corlett or Konene Streets
- Morey Street access from Morey Street
- Rotorua Racecourse Access after 9am off Fenton Street (only available when the reserve is not in use for Race Meetings or other functions)
- Jackson Park access from Springfield Road, McDowell Street & Otonga Road
- Hannahs Bay Reserve Dogs must be on a leash from the entrance to the reserve at Willow Ave including the area to the lake foreshore, the wetland area to the south, to the north-eastern drain in the centre of the reserve
- Hamurana Access from Hamurana Road
- Karenga Park Bennetts Road
- Puarenga Reserve Sala Street

Part of the Devon Street West/Utuhina Stream Reserve located between Devon Street West (opposite International Stadium & playing fields) and the banks of Utuhina Stream.

### Parks where you CAN NOT exercise your dog:

- Smallbone Park NO DOGS
- Tihiotonga (Sloane Avenue Reserve) NO DOGS
- South end of Kuirau Park NO DOGS
- Government Gardens area bounded by QE Hospital, Lakefront & Golf Course NO DOGS. This includes Motutara walking track.

### NO DOGS ALLOWED IN THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT

The following streets comprise the Central Business District:

- a) All of Tutanekai, Hinemaru, Amohia, Whakaue, Pukaki, Arawa, Haupapa Streets.
- b) Fenton Street from Victoria Street intersection to Whakaue Street intersection
- c) Pukuatua Street from Ranolf Street to Hinemaru Street
- d) Hinemoa Street from Ranolf Street to Hinemaru Stsreet
- e) Eruera Street from Ranolf Street to Hinemaru Street
- f) Amohau Street from Ranolf Street to Hinemaru Street




