



INDEPENDENT HEARING PANEL

1. As required by Minute #5, the applicant's agent, The Property Group, provided a response to twelve of the thirteen Council's s.92 further information requests and a Social Impact Assessment (SIA) on Wednesday, 11 May 2022.
2. Furthermore, on the applicants' behalf, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Development has formally requested that those 12 applications be publicly notified.
3. Application RC17894 – Rotorua International Motor Inn at 2 & 6 Monokia Street, 1 & 1B Salisbury Road, Fairy Springs remains to be determined.
4. Council will now proceed with notification for submissions and a timetable for subsequent processing will be advised by the Panel in due course.
5. Those prospective parties who filed unsolicited notification submissions should advise the Panel in writing as to whether those (clearly and individually identified) should be accepted as submissions or deleted. As a default position, the Panel will not accept any of those previously lodged "submissions" unless so advised.
