WAITETI BLOCK, NGONGOTAHA - SUITABILITY FOR DEVELOPMENT PRELIMINARY GEOTECHNICAL APPRAISAL

Further to your request we have considered the geotechnical aspects that may affect the development of the block of land adjacent to the Waiteti Stream and Hamurana Road, Ngongotaha.

The assessment comprised a review of background data from our geotechnical database for the general area, discussions with Council officers and a brief walkover inspection. No subsurface investigations were undertaken.

The site comprises an area of gently rolling farmland between Hamurana Road, Waiteti Stream and the railway line. It appears to have a somewhat limited freeboard to the Waiteti Stream.

Based on the walkover inspection of the site and our experience from similar, low-lying, sites around Lake Rotorua there are a number of ground hazards which have the potential to adversely affect the suitability of the site for development. Some examples of the issues that need to be considered include (the list is not comprehensive):

- Soft sedimentary soils, including peat;
- · High groundwater levels;
- Liquefaction under strong earthquake shaking;
- Non-engineered filling (possibly old sludge pits?);
- Interaction effects with other hazards for example, ground settlement affecting freeboard of buildings against flooding.

The assessment would need to consider building development and infrastructure such as buried services and roading.

It is clear that a detailed geotechnical assessment would be needed to demonstrate the suitability of this for development. A subsurface investigation would be essential. The amount of subsequent work (analysis, monitoring, etc) would depend on the investigation results.

The geotechnical assessment would need to be undertaken by a Chartered Professional Engineer with competence in geotechnical engineering.
